How Do I Register My Child

1. Complete the front and back of the colored Summer PACK Registration Form.
2. **Return** Summer PACK Registration Form to **LaGrange Elementary School**, 600 Straw Street, Tomah, WI 54660 or **your child's teacher** by May 31st.
3. You will receive your child's class schedule and bus pick-up and drop-off times by June 18th. You may also view your child's schedule on-line if you have parental access after June 15th.

1st Grade Here We Come

We will be offering a special Summer PACK class just for our students going into 1st grade called First Grade Here We Come. This class will allow these students to stay together throughout the day. We have found that these little ones often struggle with the stairs and maneuvering around the middle school. Therefore, we are offering something just for them on the bottom floor of the middle school. We will even be able to have these students have recess and lunch on their own, rather than with all the older students. If your child attended Getting Ready for 5K last year, the structure will be much the same, except the classes will be at the middle school.

Learning activities include:

- Reading and Math
 - All children will have the opportunity to advance their skills in reading and math each day. They will have time to enjoy numbers and letters and putting them all together.
- Science and the Outdoors
 - All children will explore the world around them and the science that makes up our everyday lives. They will use their five senses to explore with hands-on activities.
- The Artist in You
 - All children can create and share their beauty with the world. This portion of the day will help each child do just that with their classmates. Your imagination is the most important tool you will need to bring to school every day! This class will: inspire the artist, move the performer, and wake up the actor inside of you through a variety of creative art, music, and drama activities. Every child has his/her own unique imagination that needs to be fostered.

This class is just for students entering 1st Grade in the fall and promises to be fun and adventurous!

 - There will not be classes on July 4 and 5

 - Adult breakfast and lunch is available for a small fee if you join us.
- Bus transportation will be provided from and to designated points for students who attend all day long.
